I am directed to inform all concerned that with reference to the above, the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to relax the norms followed by this Hon'ble Court for the requirement of prior permission to purchase cars from "regular or reputed dealers" by the Judicial Officers in connection with the Judgement dated 04.01.2024 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in WP(C) no. 643 of 2015 regarding implementation of the recommendations of the SNJPC.

In doing so, I am to inform you that the Hon'ble Court has been pleased to grant approval to dispense with, atleast for a period of one year, the requisite prior permission by the Judicial Officers while purchasing cars with ex-showroom price upto Rupees Fifteen Lakh (Rs. 15,00,000/-) for standard Petrol /Diesel/ Green/Hybrid models from **"regular or reputed dealers"** and only post-facto intimation about the same by the Judicial Officers across all cadres in the prescribed proforma of the Checklist, may satisfactorily be accepted by the Sanctioning Authority **atleast for a period of one year with effect from 7th May 2024**.

In this connection, I am to request you to cause circulation of the above direction amongst all the WBJS officers posted in your Judgeship / under your control / posted on deputation in the various departments of Government of West Bengal, requesting them to act accordingly.
