It is notified for information of all concerned that in pursuance of the direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed on 04.01.2024 in W.P (Civil) No-643 of 2015 (All India Judges Association - vs. - Union of India & Ors.) in respect of providing Concurrent Charge Allowance to the Judicial Officers, read with the Judicial Department's Order No.1130-J/JD/V/2A-03/20 (PART III) Dated 03.04.2024 on the subject and the Resolution of the CSCDJ, High Court, Calcutta dated 07.05.2024 in the matter, the Hon'ble High Court has been pleased to decide that the concerned District Judge/Chief Judge/Head of the Office -- as the case may be, shall determine the percentage of Concurrent Charge Allowance to be available to the Officers across all cadres, within the ceiling of maximum @10% of the minimum of the scale of the additional post held beyond a period of ten working days, on the basis of the number of days worked, the quantum of judicial work turned out and the administrative work handled, without any insistence on the performance of 'appreciable judicial work' of the Court concerned.

The above decision shall apply with effect from 1.1.2016.
