In view of the **bye-elections to 35-Raiganj, 90-Ranaghat Dakshin (SC), 94-Bagda (SC) and 167-Maniktala Assembly Constituencies** on 10th July, 2024 (Wednesday), the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High Court, Calcutta, has been pleased to declare the **10th July, 2024 (Wednesday)** as **'Holiday'** for the Sub-ordinate Courts and Offices situated within the extent of those Assembly Constituencies only, where such bye-elections will be held on that date.

His Lordship has further been pleased to direct that the officers and members of the staff of the High Court/Subordinate Courts of West Bengal who are residents and bona fide voters of those Parliamentary/Assembly Constituencies where polling will be held on 10th July, 2024 (Wednesday), shall be permitted to cast their votes by way of granting **'Special Leave'** in favour of them, if applied for in writing with documentary evidence. In case of **re-poll**, the officers and members of the staff of the High Court/ Subordinate Courts may be allowed to cast their votes on the date of re-poll also in the same manner.
