It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High Court, Calcutta, upon recommendation of the Hon'ble Covid Committee of this Hon'ble Court, has been pleased to pass the following orders with regard to the modalities of the functioning of the Calcutta High Court with effect from August 17, 2020, amid the prevailing Covid-19 pandemic:

- For the two weeks beginning August 17, 2020, three Division Benches will be sitting every working day from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. Two of such Division Benches will take up criminal matters, including bail and other urgent criminal matters to be taken up by a Division Bench. The third Division Bench will take up non-criminal matters, including Original Side matters.
- In addition, there will be three Single Benches every working day, functioning from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m.
- That apart, the Chief Justice's Bench will take up PIL and such other matters as may be deemed fit by the Hon'ble the Chief Justice.
