It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that as a result of the abatement of COVID-19 Pandemic and with a view to gradually reverting to the physical mode of Court functioning, the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High Court, Calcutta, upon consideration of the recommendations of the Hon'ble Covid Committee of this Hon'ble Court, has been pleased to pass the following orders, which will come into effect from 15th February, 2021:

- 1. Gate-F of the High Court will remain open for the entry and exit of the Ld. Lawyers and their clerks only, subject to their undergoing thermal temperature screening at or near the gate, as per the existing norms. Limited number of cars of Ld. Lawyers can be accommodated in the parking space accessible through Gate-F.
- 2. The Appellate Side Cause list is allowed to be printed. For distribution, the system being followed prior to imposition of the lock-down in March, 2020 as a result of the COVID 19 pandemic, will be resumed.
- 3. The Original Side Cause list is allowed to be printed. For distribution, the system being followed prior to imposition of the lock-down in March, 2020 as a result of the COVID 19 pandemic, will be resumed.
- 4. Hearing suits and application connected thereto and election petitions, on Original Side in Court Room No. 39, shall be through physical form only.
- 5. Mentioning can be made in physical, virtual or hybrid mode.
- 6. All other prevailing notifications not contrary to the above decision shall remain in force.
