- 5.** Mentioning relating to criminal matters of Division Benches shall be made before the Division Bench presided over by Hon'ble Justice Harish Tandon (DB-III).
- 6.** Mentioning of Single Bench matters relating to civil, writ of both Appellate and Original Side shall made before Hon'ble Justice Debansu Basak (SB-II).
- 7.** Mentioning of criminal matters related to Single Benches shall be made before Hon'ble Justice Bibek Chaudhuri (SB-IX).
