It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that considering the Covid situation in the State of West Bengal is still manageable and well under control, the Hon'ble Acting Chief Justice, upon consideration of the recommendations of the Hon'ble Covid Committee, has been pleased to direct as follows:

- The existing system of Court functioning will continue subject to the following:-

The members of the Bar are requested:

- i. Not to come to Court or to remain in the Court premises when they do not have any matter or after completion of their matters in Court and not to crowd Court rooms;
- ii. Maintain social distancing, wear masks where there is conglomeration or gathering of persons

The office bearers of the Bar Associations are requested to enforce these conditions amongst members.

- Persons with cold and cough should mandatorily wear masks. A person running temperature should avoid attending Court and undergo a Covid test and follow the directions in the said advisory of the government.
- In keeping with the advisory issued by the Government, proper arrangements for sanitization should be made in designated places of the Court premises and soaps should be provided in the washrooms.
