
Sir,

I am directed to address you on the subject noted above and to state that the next Half-yearly Departmental Examination of the officers of the Government of West Bengal (including A.I.S. officers) will be held in Kolkata on and from the **4th February, 2016**. The results of the last Half-yearly Departmental Examination of the officers of the Government of West Bengal (including A.I.S. officers)- May, 2015 held from the 13th July, 2015 to 28th July, 2015 is expected to be publish within the month of December, 2015. The copies of results will be forwarded to you for your information and communication to the officers concerned, if any, of your Department / Directorate / Office who appeared at the said examination.

In this connection I am to refer to rule 4 of Chapter-II(A) of the Services (Training & Examination) Rules, West Bengal and to request that the Commission may be furnished with a statement (in duplicate) in the enclosed proforma showing the names and particulars of the officers who are liable and intending to appear at the next Half-yearly Departmental Examination of the officers of the Government of West Bengal (including A.I.S. officers), November, 2015 to be held in the Commission's Examination Hall. E-Mail-ID (dsexampscwb@gmail.com.)** Names of officers received after the **closing date (i.e. the 12th January, 2016)** will not be accepted by the Commission.


Particulars furnished in respect of the examinees concerned are sometimes found to be incorrect and/or incomplete. Preparation of results on the basis of such incorrect/incomplete particulars would lead to publication of incorrect results in these cases. I am accordingly to request you to ensure that the relevant columns of the prescribed proforma are filled in properly in respect of each and every examinee and in column 4 of the enclosed proforma, subject(s) in which an examinee is still liable to examination should be very clearly indicated.

ADVANCE COPIES OF APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE COMMISSION.

Officers not belonging to Government of West Bengal (including those temporarily undergoing training in this state) will not be permitted to appear at the Departmental Examination meant for the officers under the Government of West Bengal. You are requested not to send the names of such officers. IT IS ALSO REQUESTED THAT WHILE SENDING NAMES AND PARTICULARS OF ELIGIBLE AND INTENDING OFFICERS YOU SHOULD CERTIFY THAT THE OFFICERS BELONG TO THE GOVERNMENT OF WEST BENGAL.

You are also requested to send your office e-mail-ID and any change in office address (if any) positively to the undersigned immediately for further communication.
