The Hon'ble Justice Siddhartha Chattopadhyay will sit singly, on 26.12.2017 in Court Room No. 6 and take only urgent matters relating to Civil, Writ and Criminal Jurisdictions filed during vacation or with leave of the Regular

The Hon'ble Justice Md. Mumtaz Khan will sit singly, on 28.12.2017 in Court Room No. 7 and take only urgent matters relating to Criminal Jurisdictions filed during vacation or with leave of the Regular Bench.

Will sit singly and take <u>only urgent matters</u> relating to Criminal Jurisdictions filed during vacation or with leave of the Regular Bench.

The Hon'ble Justice Rajasekhar Mantha
