His Lordship has further been pleased to direct that the officers and members of the staff of the High Court/Subordinate Courts who are residents and bona-fide voters in a particular Parliamentary Constituency/Assembly Constituency where polling will be held on a particular day, but serve in the High Court/Subordinate Courts where polling will not be held on the same day, may be given the opportunity to cast their votes on the respective day of poll of that particular Parliamentary Constituency/Assembly Constituency by way of granting 'Special Leave' in favour of them, if applied for in writing with documentary evidence. In case of re-poll, the officers and members of the staff of the High Court/ Subordinate Courts may be allowed to cast their votes on the date of re-poll also in the same manner.
