It is notified for information of all concerned that **the Hon'ble the Chief Justice**, **High Court**, **Calcutta has been pleased to declare the 19<sup>th</sup> November**, **2016** as a 'Holiday' for Subordinate Courts and Offices situated within the extent of the 1-Cooch Behar(SC) Parliamentary Constituency (in the district of Cooch Behar), and **30-Tamluk Parliamentary Constituency** (in the district of Purba Medinipur), **including those Subordinate Courts and Offices**, **if any**, **situated within the respective Constituencies only**, **where such bye-elections will be held on the particular date**, keeping conformity with the provisions contained in the Notification No. 5596-F(P<sub>2</sub>) dated 27.10.2016, read with Memorandum No. 5595-F(P<sub>2</sub>) dated 27.10.2016, issued by the Finance (Audit) Department, Government of West Bengal.

The Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High Court, Calcutta has further been pleased to declare that the officers and members of the staff of the High Court/Subordinate Courts of West Bengal who are residents and bonafide voters of those Constituencies where polling will be held on 19.11.2016, but serve in the High Court/Subordinate Courts outside the polling area, may be permitted to cast their votes by way of sanctioning late arrival in office or early departure therefrom; or by granting 'Special Casual Leave' on that day if the working place is located at such a distance that it will not be possible for them to exercise their franchise without absenting themselves from their duties, if applied for in writing with documentary evidence.
