In view of the **bye-elections to 6-Sitai (SC), 14-Madarihat (ST), 104-Naihati, 121-Harua, 236-Medinipur and 251-Taldangra Assembly Constituencies** on 13th November, 2024 (Wednesday), the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High Court, Calcutta, has been pleased to declare the **13th November, 2024 (Wednesday)** as '**Holiday**' for the Sub-ordinate Courts and Offices situated within the extent of those Assembly Constituencies only, where such bye-elections will be held on that date.

His Lordship has further been pleased to direct that the officers and members of the staff of the High Court/Subordinate Courts of West Bengal who are residents and bona fide voters of those Assembly Constituencies where polling will be held on 13th November, 2024 (Wednesday), shall be permitted to cast their votes by way of granting '**Special Leave**' in favour of them, if applied for in writing with documentary evidence. In case of **re-poll**, the officers and members of the staff of the High Court/Subordinate Courts may be allowed to cast their votes on the date of re-poll also in the same manner.
