			<p>Let the said missing part, be part of the judgement and order dated 11th January, 2018.</p> <p>Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and having further considered the facts and circumstances of the case and for the ends of justice, we modify our order dated 11th January, 2018 to the following effect :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i) The rally will resume on 15th January, 2018 i.e. the rally shall not take place on 13th and 14th January, 2018. We do not interfere with the programme that has been fixed by the persons participating in the rally. ii) The motorcyclists and the pillion riders would wear protective headgears i.e. helmets for their own safety. iii) The motorcyclists should strictly abide by the traffic rules. <p>Mr. Basu is apprehensive about the safety of the members of the rally.</p> <p>We have no doubt, in our mind, that the police authorities will do the needful.</p> <p>The other directions in our order dated 11th January, 2018 remain unaltered.</p> <p>Naturally, in view of the aforesaid, the concluding date of the rally stand extended till 20th January, 2018.</p>
