

# **IN THE HIGH COURT AT CALCUTTA**

## **NOTIFICATION**

**No. 1947 – RG.**

**Date: 18.07.2020.**

It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that having regard to the prevailing Covid-19 situation in the State, **the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, High Court, Calcutta** has been pleased to pass the following directions:

1. All the judicial and administrative works of High Court, Calcutta shall remain suspended from Monday, the 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 till Wednesday, the 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2020 and also on Friday, the 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2020.
2. Courts, as determined by the Hon'ble the Chief Justice, will sit on Thursday, the 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2020.
3. If any extremely urgent matter is required to be taken up during the aforesaid period, the advocate on record for the petitioner shall write a letter addressing the Registrar General pointing out the specific urgency in the matter. That shall be placed before the Hon'ble the Chief Justice. On being satisfied with regard to urgency, the Hon'ble Chief Justice may direct for holding of Court(s) on case to case basis. The sitting for such purpose shall be held from the residence of the Hon'ble Judge(s) concerned.

This order is issued in continuation of this Hon'ble Court's Notification No. 1928-RG dated 09.07.2020 followed by Notification No. 1946-RG dated 13.07.2020.
