1. No need to mention any fresh filed cases, as all matters which are complete in all respect and assigned permanent number will be listed before the Courts concerned, automatically.

2. Mentioning of matters shall be done before the concerned Benches according to determination. Physical mentioning is also permitted subject to maintaining Covid-19 protocols.
3. Apart from Virtual, hearing by Hybrid mode is also allowed. But in Court Rooms not more than 15 persons are allowed to stay at any time apart from the Court staff. Rest of the Counsels would be requested to wait for their turn outside the Court Rooms and maintain Covid-19 protocols inside the Court Rooms and the complex.
4. Court's sitting will be from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm and 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm.
