**Sub:- Direction of the Hon'ble Court pursuant to the Court's Notification bearing No. 2001-A & No. 2022-A both dated 09.04.2018 for transfer and posting of officers in the cadre of Civil Judge (Junior Division)/Judicial Magistrate of the West Bengal Judicial Service.**

Sir,

I am directed to inform that this Hon'ble Court has piquantly observed that most of the officers under order of transfer in terms of the Court's Notifications as mentioned above have not delivered charge even after a lapse of considerable time from the date of order and are still lingering over the matter thereby causing serious inconveniences in the respective chain of transfer, eventually frustrating the spirit of the order of transfer of this Hon'ble Court.

The Hon'ble Court has, therefore, been pleased to direct all the officers under order of transfer in the particular cadre of Civil Judge (Junior Division)/Judicial Magistrate to deliver charge latest by 11<sup>th</sup> instant (afternoon) positively otherwise they shall be deemed to be released immediately thereafter with such consequences as this Hon'ble Court may consider in exercising its administrative control.

I am, accordingly, to request you to ask all the officers under order of transfer attached to your respective judgeships to act accordingly so that the direction of the Hon'ble Court is strictly complied with words and spirit.

An early and effective action is stressed to be taken on your part with sending of compliance report to this effect.
